Woodsmoke Rebate Program

Bay Area residents can make a clean air choice and save money too! The Bay Area Air Quality Management District is offering rebates when you upgrade your current open fireplace or non EPA-certified wood burning devices. Switching to gas or a cleaner burning EPA certified wood stove or insert will reduce particulate matter air pollution and improve air quality in your neighborhood.

Available rebate (one per household) for device proposed to be installed (*Check One*):

Replacement / Changeout

Free Standing Stove

(Only when an existing stove is being replaced)

- Gas Stove **(\$600)**
- Pellet Stove **(\$600)**
- EPA Certified Wood Stove **(\$300)**

Fireplace Insert

- Gas Insert **(\$600)**
- Pellet Insert **(\$600)**
- EPA Certified Wood Insert **(\$300)**
- Gas Fire Log **(\$300)**

Required Information: In order to qualify for this rebate all the following documentation must be included with this application:

1. Utility or telephone bill showing you are resident or in business at the application location.
2. Bill of sale or invoice indicating the retailer from which the equipment was purchased
3. A scraggage certificate for any non-EPA certified wood stove destroyed, crushed or recycled (where applicable)
4. A signed certification by the applicant (below) and vendor (see page 2)

I the home/business owner, certify the following:

1. I am a full-time resident with the boundaries of The Bay Area Air Quality Management District.
2. I will be removing an operable non-EPA certified wood stove or fireplace insert or modifying an open hearth fireplace in my residence or business.
3. The non-EPA certified wood stove will be disposed of at a recycling facility that will ensure the wood stove will be properly destroyed, crushed or recycled.
4. I agree to provide Air District staff access to my residence or business to inspect the device for compliance with program requirements, if requested. I understand that the District will provide not less than 2 calendar days notice prior to this inspection.

I the retailer, certify the following:

1. The equipment was installed in the building referenced above and was not a part of a new construction project.
2. The equipment installed meets the requirements of the BAAQMD Cleaner Burning Technology Incentives Program.
3. I understand that I will forfeit any reimbursement if I provide the BAAQMD with false information or if the installation is part of a new construction project (new construction or an addition to a home where no fireplace or non-EPA certified stove previously existed).
4. The equipment removed was properly disposed of at a recycling facility (certificate to be included as part of reimbursement application).
5. The doors of the non-EPA certified wood stove will be kept at the vendors premises until the end of the program (May 31, 2008) at which time they will be disposed of at a different recycling facility to the one used for the corresponding stove.
6. I will provide District staff access to my business to inspect for compliance with the recycling provisions of this program, if requested. I understand that the District will provide not less than 2 calendar days notice prior to this inspection.
